## Cloning statement

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## New type used for cloning

This document defines and describes the data structure used to pass parameters to the clone\_statement function. It consist of three fields given by the user:

- previous\_module is the entity of the module from which the cloned statement comes
- new\_module is the entity of the module to which the cloned statement will be added. It can be the same as previous\_module
- labels is the label mapping between old labels and new labels. If the old statement has two entities with the same label (like the statement and a loop inside the statement), then the new entity must also have those two entities with the same label.
- $\bullet$  new\_module\_statement is the root statement of new\_module
